## Public Comments

Eric Reynolds - 64 Kircher Park- Commented to the Board that a construction crew worked on the holiday weekend and the noise disrupted his family party. He said he remembers the Planning Board specifically noting that construction would not take place on holidays or weekends. Reynolds also stated that he does not want Policy 2-6 Meeting Conduct to be changed so that only one person would have the right to remove someone who is disruptive in a meeting. He said the decision to remove any person from a meeting should be made by all members of the Board not just one person.

Peter Elder - 59 Dunning Avenue - Commented to the Board that Policy 2-6 Meeting Conduct should not be changed to allow one person the right to remove anyone from a meeting but the quorum of the Board should make that decision. Mr. Elder also said he would like the Village Board to schedule a public hearing for people to voice their opinion regarding a stop sign at the corner of Dunning and Elm.

Richard Walter - 20 Elm Street- Asked the Board for clarification on the policy regarding Village Board Workshops. Mr. Walter said sometimes there is audience interaction at the workshops but also sometimes they are not allowed to interact.

Motion Trustee Lancy and Seconded by Trustee Ippolito Jr., to correct the wording of Policy 2-2 Meeting Dates, Times and Locations for Boards, it was agreed upon that no time change would take place concerning Village Board Meetings, all were in favor and carried.

Policy 2-6 Meeting Conduct will be further discussed at the Village Board Workshop on August 5, 2014.

Courtesy Senior Citizen Parking in Ebaum's parking lot will be further discussed at the Village Board Meeting on July 24, 2014.
